

PILGRIM 1600 ACRE AREA


The Town of Plymouth is excited to announce the beginning of the <u>Pilgrim1600 Acre Area Planning Process!</u> As you may know, the Town is embarking on the Pilgrim 1600 Acre Area Planning Process, a community-driven initiative to reimagine the future of the land surrounding the decommissioned Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station. This property provides the backdrop for residents living in Manomet, Rocky Hill Road, Pinehills, Chiltonville, and the Eel River Valley. Over the next several months the Town of Plymouth will be engaging the community in a public input survey and series of workshops to explore the potential of the Pilgrim1600.
